## **RULE 7 - EXAMINATIONS**

### **Section 7.7 Rating Examinations**

7.7.4 Unless otherwise provided by a collective bargaining agreement, all candidates receiving a grade of 70% or above on the written examination shall advance to the remaining portions of the examination. No candidate receiving a grade below 70% on the written examination will advance to the remaining portions of the examination. Except, that candidates for Corrections Deputy receiving a grade of 65% or above on the written examination shall advance to the remaining portions of the examination.

**Section 7.8 Minimum Grades:** Any candidate who fails to attain at least a minimum grade of 70% on each section shall be considered to have failed the examination and shall not be examined on any further parts, if any are planned, unless otherwise noted for specific examinations as provided by these Rules or collective bargaining agreements. The minimum passing grade for the Corrections Deputy examination is 65%.
