Dear President Swenson and Key Peninsula Advisory Committee Members,

Thank you for your past support of the Key Peninsula Community Council and the important activities that the Council accomplishes on the Key Peninsula.

Last year, the Key Peninsula Community Council voted to support a shared office space in the Key Center Corral. This office space represents a unique KP opportunity, which through partnering with other service providers, has made it possible to add services on the KP, which previously required a trip across the Narrows Bridge. Currently the Pierce County Health Department, Safe Streets, Councilman Derek Young and Hope Recovery Center for mental health referral services are offering services and have a presence in the KPC office space on a regular basis. The Council is requesting a \$1,500 grant for continued support of the community services office during 2018.

The KP Council is a 501.c.3 organization, representing the whole Key Peninsula with 14 directors elected to 4 director districts based on population. The KPC Council does not do fundraisers and the initial rental, internet, phone, power etc. services was made possible by the generosity of the Angel Guild, and donations by board members and community members.

On behalf of the Farm Council, the Council is also requesting a \$500 grant to support advertising and permitting costs for the October 6, 2018 Farm Tour. The Tour is a community wide opportunity to visit local farming operations and the Fiber Arts Show at the Longbranch Improvement Club. The event attracts visitors from across western Washington
