Kick Bowling

Children need many opportunities to practice their traveling skills, both independently and with adult assistance. Kick bowling supports the development of your child's gross-motor skills. It also encourages them to explore cause and effect by allowing them to investigate the cause of an unexpected event.

Materials

five or more empty plastic bottles
medium-sized ball(s)

What you do

Set up the plastic bottles in one or more rows depending on how many bottles you have. Invite your child to play a bowling game. Explain that the purpose of the game is to kick the ball toward the bottles. Provide assistance if your child needs it to complete the task. *Acknowledge their efforts. You kicked the ball far. You knocked down three bottles.*

Encourage your child to help you set the bottles back up after they fall.

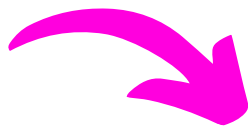
Explain what happens to the ball and the bottles.
