Random Check of Ballots

Per RCW 29A.60.170(4) a random audit of batches is required. On April 27, 2021 the political party observer coordinators requested the required audit of ballots be conducted for the Pierce County Fire Protection District No. 18, Proposition No. 1. Our system uses up to five digital scanners and one central count server. A random batch from each scanner used in the election (three in this case) was drawn, hand tallied, and compared to the machine report. All results of the hand tally for the chosen race matched the machine report.
