### How to vote



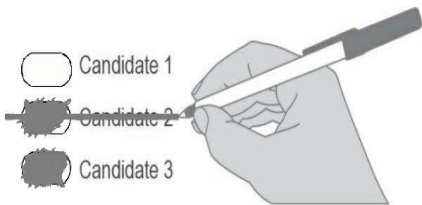
Use an ink pen to fill in the oval to the left of your choice.

Multi-Year Levy Lid Lift

The Board of Fire Commissioners of East Pierce Fire & Rescue adopted Resolution No. 940 concerning an increase in the District's property tax levy. If approved, Proposition No. 2 will authorize the District to restore the previous voter-authorized regular property tax levy rate for fire and emergency medical services of one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) of assessed valuation for collection in 2022, allow annual increases of up to six (6%) percent for each of the succeeding three (3) years and use the 2025 levy dollar amount for computing the limitation for subsequent levies. **Fire Protection District No. 16 (Key Peninsula Fire)****Special Election – Proposition No. 1**

Multi-Year Levy Lid Lift

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Pierce County Fire Protection District No. 16 adopted Resolution No. 04-21-759 concerning an increase in the District's regular property tax levy. If approved, Proposition No. 1 will restore the District's regular property tax levy for fire and emergency medical services to the previous voter-approved rate of one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) of assessed valuation for collection in 2022, set the limit factor at six percent (6%) for each of the succeeding five (5) years and use the 2027 levy dollar amount for computing the limitation for subsequent levies.
