The 5th annual Watershed Issues Forum will be held on the afternoon of Wednesday, November 17th. The forum is an annual educational event hosted by the [Chambers-Clover Creek Watershed Council](#) in WRIA 12, and is organized around a different theme each year. The theme this year is ground water. In past years, we've focused on lakes, stormwater, salmon recovery, and land stewardship. The forum typically draws between 70-100 guests and speakers. This year's forum will be hosted virtually on Zoom and it is free to attend.
