STATE ADVISORY VOTES

36-38

Advisory votes are non-binding. The results will not change the law. You are advising the Legislature to repeal or maintain a tax increase.

- **Repeal** - you don't favor the tax increase.
- **Maintain** - you favor the tax increase.

PIERCE COUNTY CHARTER AMENDMENT

NO. 51

Charter amendments seek to amend the charters of local government entities such as cities and counties.

- **Approved** - you favor the amendment.
