**Shoreline Substantial Development Permit / Shoreline Administrative Conditional Use Permit /
SEPA: Donely Pier**

Request: Installation of a 125-foot pier/ramp/float system consisting of 4'x61' overwater 100% grated aluminum pier supported by six 10-inch diameter galvanized steel piles, 3'x42' 100% grated ramp (spanning 34-feet), and an 8'x30' 50+% functional grated float supported by four 10-inch diameter galvanized steel pier piles. On-site mitigation consists of 9'x122' (1,098 square feet) 6-inch deep, totaling 20.5cubic yards of beach nourishment. Off-site mitigation to include removal and disposal of a 6'x30' pier decking (including stringers) and a 14'x40'float from 8720 184th Avenue NW (Parcel: 0021034084).
