Pierce County Human Services is making available a Substantial Amendment to the Human Services 2021 One Year Action Plan for public review and comment for 30-days from October 8 through November 10, 2021. About the 2021 One Year Action Plan

The Department of Housing and Urban Development requires Human Services to submit a One-Year Action Plan detailing the department’s 2021 allocations of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). These funds assist the homeless population and low-income people, households, and communities throughout unincorporated Pierce County, as well as the Pierce County Consortium, which consists of 19 cities and towns. This is the first amendment to the 2021 One Year Action Plan.

Substantial Amendment #1 to the 2021 One Year Action Plan

The substantial amendment to the 2021 One Year Action Plan is for the following:

- An additional \$147,446.74 of 2015 CDBG public facilities funds and an additional \$5,000 of 2021 CDBG public facilities funds will be allocated to the Pierce County Human Services Community Action Agency’s Home Repair Program for a total project award of \$1,157,511.74. (Total amount below includes \$5,000 activity delivery for Community Development staff).
