About the 2022 One Year Action Plan

Pierce County Human Services is required by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to submit to HUD annually, by May 15, a One Year Action Plan that describes community needs, resources, priorities, and proposed activities to be undertaken in Pierce County through HUD programs (Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and Home Investment Partnerships (HOME)). These funding sources are to assist lower-income people, households, and communities throughout unincorporated areas in Pierce County, as well as the Pierce County Consortium Cities and Towns.

Public Comment Period and Public Hearing
