



Thank you for your interest in the Pierce County Park Volunteer Stewardship program. Volunteer Stewards promote community stewardship and bridge the communication between the community and the County, your support sends a message that the community cares about its parks and open spaces.

Park Volunteer Stewards work to maintain and enhance park landscapes, wildlife habitats, provide program support and encourage community awareness and appreciation of county parks. This position is a renewable one-year commitment of at least 25 hours and requires volunteers to attend an on-site orientation prior to participation in the program. Potential stewards will not be recognized under the program until filing out this application, associated waivers, assigned a park or trail, and completing orientation.

Pierce County Parks accepts applications year-round. If there are no parks or trails available or within your area of interest, we will place you on a waiting list and invite you to stay engaged in stewardship events and training.
