### **Information about the CAPER**

On an annual basis Human Services receives three formula grants from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD):

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG);
- Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG); and the
- HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME).

The CAPER describes how the grant funds expended from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022, helped carry out the housing, homeless, and community development objectives, strategies and activities outlined in Human Services 2021 One Year Action Plan. As a condition of the grants, the department must submit the CAPER to HUD on or before September 30.
