**About the 2022 One Year Action Plan**

The Department of Housing and Urban Development requires Human Services to submit a One-Year Action Plan detailing the department’s 2022 allocations of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). These funds assist the homeless population and low-income people, households, and communities throughout unincorporated Pierce County, as well as the Pierce County Consortium, which consists of 19 cities and towns. This is the fourth amendment to the 2022 One Year Action Plan.

**Substantial Amendment #4 to the 2022 One Year Action Plan**

This substantial amendment to the 2022 One Year Action Plan is for the following:

- In the 2018 One Year Action Plan – Lindquist Dental Clinic for Children/Parkland Dental Clinic Facility Improvements project was awarded 2018 CDBG funds in the amount of \$67,590. This amendment is to increase the award amount by \$15,735 for a total CDBG award of \$83,325. Please note the funding amount below includes \$5,000 for activity delivery for Human Services staff to manage the project.
