City of Tacoma (253) 591-5171	Proposition No. 1 - Resolution No. 36889 concerns a proposition to increase the City's Emergency Medical Services regular property tax levy. City of Tacoma (253) 591-5171	Initiative No. 1 - Resolution 36754 concerns allowing existing mini casinos to continue to operate. If approved by the voters, this initiative would amend Substitute Ordinance 26515, allowing four (4) existing state-licensed mini casinos in the City of Tacoma to continue to operate. The prohibition on new casinos would remain.	Simple Majority
Pierce County Fire Protection District No. 2 (Lakewood Fire Department) (253) 377-3132	Resolution No. 071006-008 concerns a proposition to finance Maintenance and Operation expenses. If approved, the District would be re-authorized to levy in 2006 and 2007, a property tax of approximately \$1.191 per \$1,000 assessed valuation for collection in 2007 and 2008. Levy amount: \$5,508,607 and \$5,776,325.	3,366 Yes votes + a 60% favorable majority
Pierce County Fire Protection District No. 5 (Gig Harbor Fire & Medic One) (253) 851-3111	Resolution No. 2006-06 concerns a proposition to re-authorize the previously existing property tax levy rate.
