District/Proposition or Initiative No.	Issue	Required to Pass
State of Washington Initiative to the People 747	Concerns limiting property tax increases. This measure would require state & local governments to limit property tax levy increases to 1% per year, unless an increase greater than this limit is approved by the voters at an election	Simple Majority
State of Washington Initiative to the People 773	Concerns additional tobacco taxes for low-income health programs & other programs. This measure would impose an additional sales tax on cigarettes & a surtax on wholesaled tobacco products. The proceeds would be earmarked for existing programs & expanded health care services for low-income persons	Simple Majority
State of Washington Initiative to the People 775	Concerns long-term in-home care services. This measure would create a "home care quality authority" to establish qualifications, standards, accountability, training, referral & employment relations for publicly funded individual providers of in-home care services to elderly & disabled adults	Simple Majority
State of Washington Engrossed Senate Joint Resolution 8208	The Legislature has proposed a constitutional amendment on the use of temporary superior court judges (judges pro tempore). This amendment would allow superior courts to bring in elected Washington judges from other court levels to hear cases on a temporary basis, subject to certain restrictions, as implemented by supreme court rules	Simple Majority
State of Washington House Joint Resolution 4202	The Legislature has proposed a constitutional amendment on the investment of state funds. This amendment would grant increased discretion to the Legislature in deciding how to invest state funds. Funds under the authority of the state investment board could be invested as determined by state statute	Simple Majority
Pierce County (City of Bonney Lake)  Prop. 1 - 6	Shall certain territory in unincorporated Pierce County located adjacent to the current city limits of Bonney Lake be annexed to and become part of the City of Bonney Lake? Annexation areas 2 through 7	Simple Majority
Pierce County (Whiteman's Cove Water Dist.)  Prop. 7	Shall the Whiteman's Cove Water District be dissolved?  Whiteman's Cove Water District has indebtedness requiring the election of a receiver - Peninsula Light Company nominated as a candidate	Simple Majority
Town of Eatonville  Prop. 1	A proposal that the Town adopt the classification of noncharter code city & continue the current mayor-council form of government	Simple Majority

Fire District No. 2 (Lakewood)  Prop. 1	General Obligation Bonds-\$14,300,000-to renovate the Steilacoom Blvd. station & training facility, renovate the Oakbrook station, acquire a ladder truck, construct & equip a station on Pacific Hwy. & a vehicle maintenance facility & renovate or rebuild the Tillicum station.	8,473 TOTAL votes + a 60% favorable margin
Fire District No. 3 (University Place)  Prop. 1	Maintenance & Operation Levy-\$.70/1,000 of assessed valuation, to provide \$1,227,528 to be levied in 2001, collected in 2002	3,311 YES votes + a 60% favorable margin
Fire District No. 13 (Browns/Dash Point)  Prop. 1	To increase the District's regular tax levy from \$1.00 to \$1.50/1,000 assessed valuation as allowed by RCW 52.16.130 & RCW 52.16.160 & notwithstanding the otherwise applicable limitations contained in RCW Chapter 84.55, with proceeds to finance maintenance & operation expenses. (106% Lid Lift)	Simple Majority
Fire District No. 15 (Eatonville)  Prop. 1	To increase the District's regular tax levy from \$1.00 to \$1.50/1,000 assessed valuation as allowed by RCW 52.16.130 & RCW 52.16.160 & notwithstanding the otherwise applicable limitations contained in RCW Chapter 84.55, with proceeds to finance maintenance & operation expenses. (106% Lid Lift)	Simple Majority
Fire District No. 17 (Roy/Lacamas/McKenna)  Prop. 1	Emergency Medical Services Levy-levy \$.50/1,000 of assessed valuation for each of six consecutive years, beginning in 2001, to continue to provide emergency medical services & adding basic life support ambulance transport services	878 YES votes + a 60% favorable margin
Fire District No. 17 (Roy/Lacamas/McKenna)  Prop. 2	To increase the District's regular tax levy from \$1.00 to \$1.50/1,000 assessed valuation as allowed by RCW 52.16.130 & RCW 52.16.160 & notwithstanding the otherwise applicable limitations contained in RCW Chapter 84.55, with proceeds to finance maintenance & operation expenses. (106% Lid Lift)	Simple majority
