<b>City of Bonney Lake</b>	<p><b>Formation of Metropolitan Park District</b>                      The Bonney Lake City Council pass Resolution No. 2266, concerning formation of a metropolitan park district. If approved, Proposition No. 1 would result in the creation of the "Bonney Lake Metropolitan Park District," with boundaries co-extensive with the City limits, to be governed by the City Council as the ex officio board of parks commissioners. If created, the metropolitan park district would have all powers under Chapter 35.61 RCW, including authority to levy a general property tax, and to provide improved parks and recreation facilities and services.</p>	Simple Majority
<b>City of Milton</b>	<p><b>Authorizing Annexation of the City of Milton into Pierce County Fire Protection District No. 22 (East Pierce Fire &amp; Rescue)</b></p> <p>This measure would authorize the annexation of the City of Milton into Pierce County Fire Protection District No.22 (East Pierce Fire &amp; Rescue). To pass a majority of the registered voters within the City, and a majority of the registered voters within the fire district, must approve the annexation.</p> <p>Ownership of the city's fire department apparatus and equipment will transfer to East Pierce Fire &amp; Rescue, which will use the Milton Fire stations. Ownership of the stations will remain with the City of Milton.</p>	Simple Majority within City of Milton <i>and</i> Simple Majority in FPD 22
<b>Fire Protection District No. 18 (Orting Valley Fire &amp; Rescue)</b>	<p><b>Excess Property Tax Levy for Maintenance and Operation Expenses</b>                      Adopted Resolution No. 2012-015 concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operation expenses. If approved, Proposition No. 1 will authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes on all taxable property within the District to be used for maintenance and operations to maintain the current level of fire and emergency medical services.</p> <p>\$825,000 for collection in 2014, \$825,000 in 2015, \$825,000 in 2016 and \$825,000 in 2017.</p>	1,461 <b>YES</b> votes plus a 60% favorable margin
