There was no evidence of tampering and the box was securely locked. Drop boxes are uniquely keyed. Do we count these ballots?

RANDOM CHECK OF BATCHES:
 On August 6, 2013, representatives of the Republican and Democratic political parties requested a manual tally of ballots. The request was made to perform a random check of Port of Tacoma Commissioner Position No. 1. Batches of ballots and machines were chosen at random. All results matched exactly, no discrepancies were found. The audit was performed on August 7 in the presence of the official political party observers.

TOUCH SCREEN AUDIT:
 In accordance with state law, Pierce County conducted an audit of results of votes cast on the touch screen voting machines. The Port of Tacoma Commissioner Position No. 1 was selected and three machines audited. To conduct the audit, an election worker read the results from the voter verifiable paper audit trail and another election worker tallied the results. These results were compared to the results accumulated in the election tabulation system. No discrepancies or anomalies were found. The audit was conducted on the following machines:
