### WRITE-IN TALLY

Write-in votes were reviewed and tallied in the following races:

#### **29th Legislative District - State Representative, Position No. 2**

- This race only had one candidate on the Primary ballot.
- A write-in candidate would need to receive a total of 116 votes (1%) to qualify for the General Election.
- No individual candidate came close to reaching this individual threshold.
- No valid write-in candidate received greater than eight votes.

#### **Pierce County Prosecuting Attorney**

- This race only had one candidate on the Primary ballot.
- A write-in candidate would need to receive a total of 1,213 votes (1%) to qualify for the General Election.
- No individual candidate came close to reaching this individual threshold.
- No valid write-in candidate received greater than 17 votes.

#### **County Council - District No. 1**

- This race only had one candidate on the Primary ballot.
- A write-in candidate would need to receive a total of 166 votes (1%) to qualify for the General Election.
- No individual candidate came close to reaching this individual threshold.
- No valid write-in candidate received greater than four votes.

#### **County Council - District No. 5**

- This race only had one candidate on the Primary ballot.
- A write-in candidate would need to receive a total of 117 votes (1%) to qualify for the General Election.
- No individual candidate came close to reaching this individual threshold.
- No valid write-in candidate received greater than three votes.

#### **County Council - District No. 7 and District Court Position No. 8**

- Due to the closeness of these races the write-in votes were reviewed.
- No write-in votes were cast for any candidates on the ballot.
