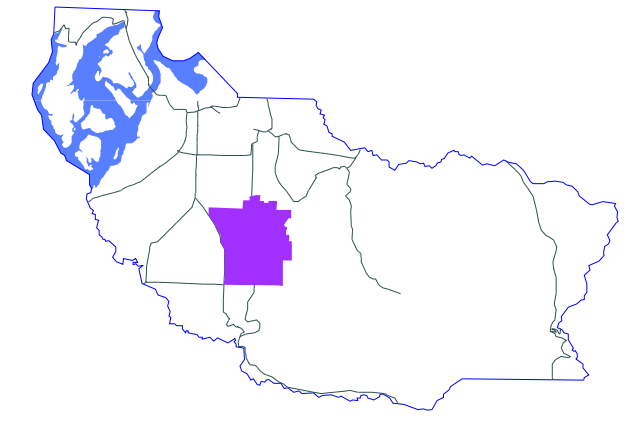

Additional Trail Areas Under Consideration

- 1 Pierce County Elk Plain Road Shop property with dedicated trail to Bethel High School.
- 2 Bonneville Power Line, from Mountain Hwy. and 288th St. E. to Orville Road, south of Orting.
- 3 Tacoma Mountain Railway Trail
- 4 McKenna-Orting Trail

Additional Park Areas Under Consideration

- 5 25 acre parcel on 46th Ave. E. and north of 240th St. E.
- 6 Cougar Mountain Park on 26th St. E., and east of 54th Ave. E.
- 7 Possible Community Passive Nature Trail adjacent to the Morse Preserve at 260th St. E., east of 54th Ave. E.
- 8 Lincoln Tree Farm, east of Mountain Hwy. and north of 288th St. E.
- 9 Scenic Overlook, on Meridian, at the top of Graham Hill.
- 10 Possible expansion of Frontier Park, on south side for trails.
- 11 Puyallup River Trail Park.
- 12 Joint Pierce County/State Park, at the north end of Lake Kapowsin.
- 13 Willmott Farm, wetlands and forest trails, on 122nd Ave. E.
- 14 Other designated locations along Muck and South Creeks, to be specified at a later date.
- 15 Puyallup River and other water bodies, to be specified at a later date.
