<b>Yelm Community Schools</b> Proposition No. 1	<b>Replacement of Expiring Educational Programs Maintenance and Operations Levy</b> Authorizes the District to levy excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, for the support of the District's educational programs, maintenance and operations. \$10,700,000 for collection in 2017, \$11,200,000 in 2018, 11,700,000 in 2019 and \$12,300,000 in 2020.	Simple Majority
<b>Yelm Community Schools</b> Proposition No. 2	<b>Bonds to Construct and Renovate School Facilities, and Make Safety Improvements</b> Authorizes the Distirct to: construct a new Southworth Elementary School, construct a new Yelm Middle School, renovate Prairie Elementary School, construct a new 9th Grade Campus at Yelm High School, make District-wide safety and security improvements, and relocate Technology Center; issue no more than \$59,500,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 21 years; and levy annual excess property taxes for paying bonds.	2,232 <b>Total Votes</b> plus a 60% favorable majority
<b>Carbonado Historical School District No. 19</b> Proposition No. 1	<b>Replacement Educational Programs and Operations Levy</b> Authorizes the District to levy excess taxes, to replace an expiring levy, for the support of the District's educational programs and operations. \$583,000 for collection in 2017, \$595,000 in 2018, \$607,000 in 2019 and \$619,000 in 2020.	Simple Majority
<b>Carbonado Historical School District No. 19</b> Proposition No. 2	<b>General Obligation Bonds - \$1,750,000</b> Authorizes the District to modernize, upgrade and replace portions of the Historical School building; to provide safety and security upgrades; to provide for ADA compliance; to issue \$1,750,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum of 20 years; and to levy additional property taxes annually to repay the bonds.	147 <b>Total Votes</b> plus a 60% favorable majority

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<b>Sumner School</b> <b>District No. 320</b> Proposition No. 1	<b>General Obligation Bonds - \$145,600,000</b> Authorizes the District to: build a new elementary school and early learning center, replace Emerald Hills Elementary School, expand and modernize Sumner High School, expand Bonney Lake High School and Mountain View Middle School, and make middle school field and District-wide safety and security improvements; issue no more than \$145,600,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds.	3,149 <b>Total Votes</b> plus a 60% favorable majority
<b>Dieringer School</b> <b>District No. 343</b> Proposition No. 1	<b>Replacement Maintenance and Operations Levy</b> Authorizes the District to meet the educational needs of its students by levying the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund educational maintenance and operations expenses. \$6,950,000 for collection in 2017, \$7,325,000 in 2018.	Simple Majority
<b>Orting School</b> <b>District No. 344</b> Proposition No. 1	<b>Replacement Maintenance and Operations Levy</b> Authorizes the District to levy the following excess taxes, to replace an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, to support the District's educational maintenance and daily operations, including teachers, staff, classroom materials and textbooks. \$4,350,000 for collection in 2017, \$4,475,000 in 2018.	Simple Majority
<b>Clover Park School</b> <b>District No. 400</b> Proposition No. 1	<b>Replacement Educational Programs and Operations Levy</b> Authorizes the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund educational programs and operations expenses. \$23,500,000 for collection in years 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020.	Simple Majority

<b>Peninsula School District No. 401</b> Proposition No. 1	<b>Continuing Educational Programs and Operations Levy</b> Authorizes the District to levy the following excess taxes on all taxable property within the District to support the District's educational programs and operations. \$23,575,000 for collection in 2017, \$25,350,000 in 2018, \$26,750,000 in 2019, and \$27,690,000 in 2020.	Simple Majority
<b>Bethel School District No. 403</b> Proposition No. 1	<b>General Obligation Bonds - \$236,700,000</b> Authorizes the District to replace or renovate six elementary, middle and high schools; construct one elementary school; repair roofs; upgrade security, alarm and fire sprinklers and technology infrastructure; make earthquake and safety improvements; install energy-efficient heating and lighting; and construct or improve playfields and athletic facilities by issuing \$236,700,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 20 years and levying annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds.	6,046 <b>Total Votes</b> plus a 60% favorable majority
<b>Auburn School District No. 408</b> Proposition No. 1	<b>Educational Programs and Operations Replacement Levy</b> Authorizes the District to levy the following excess taxes, to replace an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, to support the District's educational program and operations. \$40,700,000 for collection in 2017, \$43,000,000 in 2018, \$45,400,000 in 2019, and \$47,750,000 in 2020.	Simple Majority
<b>White River School District No. 416</b> Proposition No. 1	<b>General Obligation Bonds - \$98,825,000</b> Authorizes the District to renovate, upgrade and/or expand building capacity at Glacier Middle School and Elk Ridge, Wilkeson, Mountain Meadow and Foothills Elementary schools; upgrade safety, security, technology equipment and community activity fields throughout the District and construct an athletic stadium at White River High School; to issue \$98,825,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum of 20 years; and to levy additional property taxes annually to repay the bonds.	1,548 <b>Total Votes</b> plus a 60% favorable majority

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<b>Fife School District No. 417</b> Proposition No. 1	<b>Capital Projects Technology Levy</b> Authorizes acquisition of educational technology, equipment and training, including classroom computers, and the following excess levies on all taxable property within the District. \$1,225,000 for collection in years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022.	Simple Majority
