

**Pierce County Community Connections  
Notice of 30-Day Public Comment Period, Public Hearing and  
Availability of 2016 One-Year Action Plan**

The Department of Housing and Urban Development requires Community Connections to submit a One-Year Action Plan detailing the department's 2016 allocations of the Community Development Block Grant, HOME and Emergency Solutions Grant. These funds assist the homeless population and low-income people, households, and communities throughout unincorporated Pierce County, as well as the Pierce County Consortium, which consists of 18 cities and towns. The public is encouraged to attend and offer feedback. Following the public comment period, the CAB will hold a public hearing on the 2016 One Year Action Plan at 6:00 p.m. on May 4.
