

Office and Personal Kit Supplies

- Nonperishable, compact, ready to eat food (3 days' supply)
- Emergency Water Packets – easy to pack and transport
- Water Purification Tablets
- Mylar Emergency Blanket
- Emergency Solar Hand Crank AM/FM/NOAA Digital Radio, Flashlight, Cell Phone Charger with NOAA Certified Weather Alert & Cables
- Phone Charger with cords
- Metal Whistle w/ Lanyard
- Pocket First Aid Kit
- Light Sticks – 12 Hour Duration
- Water (3- 16oz bottles per person, per day)
- Flashlight/headlamp and extra batteries
- Personal hygiene items, include sanitary wipes
- Extra sanitation items
- Extra clothing, sturdy shoes, socks, hat, gloves
- Extra prescription medicine and eye glasses or contact supplies "
- List of important phone numbers
- N95 dust masks (at least 5)
- Include items unique for your safety needs

Helpful:

- Have a few comfort items like books, games, cards and a pad of paper and pens
- Have a backup for information dependent on electricity
- Include a list of friends, family, physicians, kennel and other emergency phone numbers.
