You have been ordered to complete one or more treatment programs (i.e. substance abuse, anger management). You are solely responsible for providing proof of completion to this Court. Reports must be on Agency letterhead. The Court requires that evaluating agencies review Police Reports or Probable Cause Declarations and the Defendant's criminal case history when preparing an assessment.

NO ONLINE TREATMENT IS AUTHORIZED.
