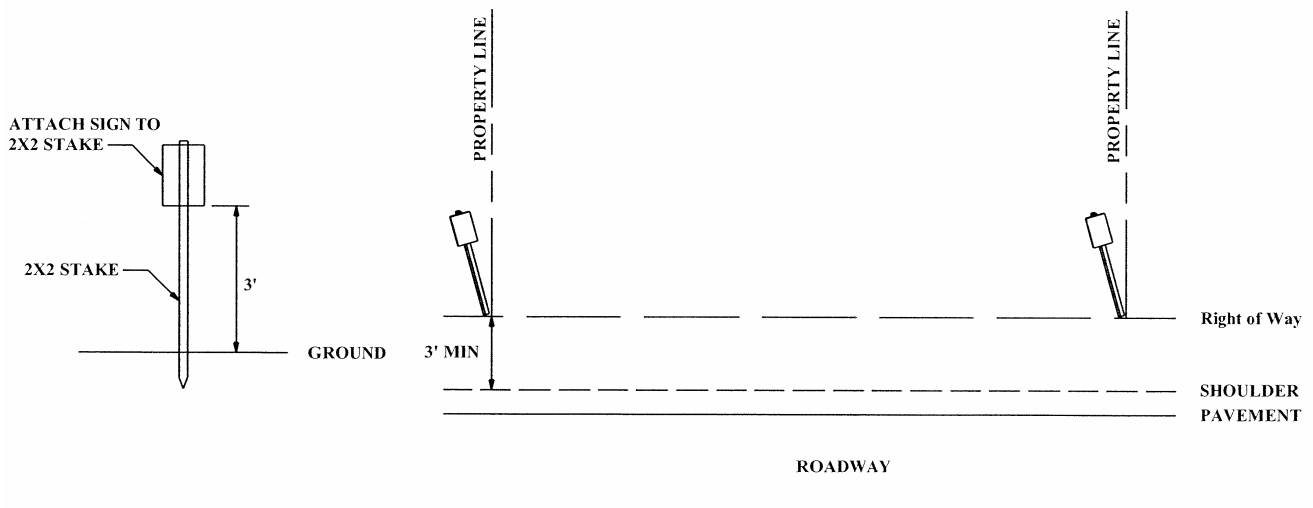
“Owner Maintain” Program Agreement
Sign Installation

Vegetation crews will be traveling in the direction that traffic flows...right side of the road.

- Use two (2) signs: Property frontage that is not at an intersection.
- Use three (3) signs: Property frontage at an intersection.

Place all signs as suggested below

- 1) Place signs on the right-of-way property line.
- 2) Place signs at the beginning and end of your property, or area, not to be maintained by vegetation crews. Place signs on an angle facing oncoming traffic so they can be read by crews as they approach your property.
- 3) Place all signs three (3) feet above the ground level. If the signs would be over a bank or down a steep slope where they can not be seen from the road, the signs should be moved closer to the road shoulder.
- 4) Never place a sign closer than three (3) feet to the road shoulder or on utility poles.
- 5) Keep all weeds, grass, brush and limbs cut away from signs so that they can be easily seen by vegetation crews. Disposal of trimmings is the responsibility of the owner.
- 6) Signs can be mounted to your fence if the above criteria are followed.
