Proposed schedule:

- July 2019 - Findings and recommendations available for stakeholder review and comment
- August- September 2019 – County and City negotiate revised Inter-Local Agreement to align resources for continued funding and support of services
- October-December 2019 – Present Inter-local agreement to County and City Councils for consideration
- December 2019 – Final authorization of new Inter-Local Agreement
