2019 One Year Action Plan

The Department of Housing and Urban Development requires Human Services to submit a One-Year Action Plan detailing the department's 2019 allocations of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). These funds assist the homeless population and low-income people, households, and communities throughout unincorporated Pierce County, as well as the Pierce County Consortium, which consists of 18 cities and towns. The County's 2019 goals and objectives for these funds are outlined in the 2019 One Year Action Plan.

Substantial Amendment #2 – 2017 One Year Action Plan

The substantial amendment to the 2017 One Year Action Plan revises the 2017 ESG budget and identifies the agencies that are receiving 2017 ESG funds.

Substantial Amendment #4 – 2018 One Year Action Plan

The substantial amendment to the 2018 One Year Action Plan adds 2017 CDBG public facilities funds in the amount of \$210,000 to the Pierce County Community Development Corporation's Housing CDBG Owner Rehab Revolving Loan Program. The YWCA/Domestic Violence Emergency Shelter Elevator project was originally awarded these 2017 public facilities funds but have cancelled their project as the project has been delayed.
