



2017 One Year Action Plan Substantial Amendment

Notice of 30-Day Public Comment Period, Public Hearing and Availability of 2018 One-Year Action Plan Amendment

Notice

Pierce County Human Services is making a Substantial Amendment to the 2017 One Year Action Plan available for public review and comment for 30 days from March 29 through May 1, 2019. The Citizens' Advisory Board will hold a public hearing on this Amendment at their May 1, 2019 meeting.

About the 2017 Action Plan Amendment

Pierce County Human Services is required by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to submit an annual Action Plan which describes the proposed program year activities to be undertaken in Pierce County under HUD programs (Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME)). These funding sources are to assist lower-income people, households, and communities throughout unincorporated areas in Pierce County, as well as the Pierce County Consortium. The substantial amendment to the 2017 One Year Action Plan revises the 2017 Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) budget and identifies the agencies that are receiving 2017 ESG funds.

Amendment #2 to the 2017 Action Plan

The 2017 One Year Action Plan was prepared and submitted with the 2017 ESG budget absent the proposed project listings. A substantial amendment was previously completed in December 2017 and included incorrect line item budgets. This substantial amendment corrects the earlier error and reflects the actual use of 2017 ESG funds.
