

### **How to vote**




Use an ink pen to fill in the oval to the left of your choice. **Do not use felt tip markers.**

Excess Property Tax Levy for Maintenance and Operation Expenses

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Pierce County Fire Protection District No. 3 (West Pierce Fire & Rescue) adopted Resolution No. 050719-005 concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operation expenses. If approved, this proposition will authorize the District to levy the following additional taxes on all taxable property within the District:

Six-Year Levy Lid Lift

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Pierce County Fire Protection District No. 3 (West Pierce Fire & Rescue) adopted Resolution No. 050719-004 concerning an increase in the District's regular property tax levy. If approved, Proposition No. 2 will restore the District's regular property tax levy for fire protection, fire suppression and other emergency services to one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) of assessed valuation in 2019, set the limit factor at one hundred six percent (106%) for each of the five (5) succeeding years, and use the 2025 levy dollar amount for computing the limitation for subsequent levies.
