

RESOLUTION NO. 19-001  
Pierce County Fire District 23

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF PIERCE COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT 23 PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE FIRE DISTRICT, AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 5<sup>th</sup> DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2019 OF A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING A LID LIFT OF THE REGULAR TAX ON TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE FIRE DISTRICT AS AUTHORIZED IN CHAPTER 84.55 RCW.

WHEREAS: Pierce County Fire District 23 did have approved by the electors in the past a regular property tax in the amount of \$1.50 per thousand dollars of assessed value of property and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF PIERCE COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT 23, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON:

Section 1: To continue to meet the existing needs for fire services and to satisfy personnel needs including training and to provide basic fire service supplies at levels in keeping with effects of inflationary costs, the district requires funds for such needs.

Section 2: For the purpose of raising revenues adequate to pay costs attributable to providing adequate fire services as described in section 1 of this resolution, and to maintain reserve funds sufficient to assure continuation of those services the district shall lift the levy lid in 2020 from \$1.18 not to exceed \$1.50 per \$1,000.00 of true and fair assessed valuation.

Section 3: There shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the district for their ratification or rejection at the general election on November 5, 2019 the proposition hereinafter set forth. The Board of Commissioners hereby declare that the Auditor of Pierce County as ex-officio Supervisor of Elections, is hereby requested to call said election and to submit the following proposition at said election in the form of a ballot title substantially as follows:

**PROPOSITION 1**  
PIERCE COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT 23

The Board of Commissioners of Pierce County Fire Protection District 23 (Ashford, Elbe, Alder) proposes to reauthorize the previously existing regular property tax levy rate. If passed, Proposition 1 would permit the district to increase the levy, beginning collection in 2020, for regular property tax from \$1.18 not to exceed \$1.50 (a 32 cent increase) per \$1000.00 of assessed valuation, thereby lifting the revenue limitations in Chapter 84.55 RCW. Should Proposition No. 1 be approved or rejected?




