Per RCW 29A.60.170(4) a random audit of batches is required. On August 6, 2019 the political party observer coordinators requested the required audit of ballots be conducted for the Port of Tacoma Commissioner - Position 3 race. Our system uses five digital scanners and one central count server. A random batch from each scanner was drawn, hand tallied, and compared to the machine report. All results of the hand tally for the chosen race matched the machine report.
