



## Petition for Adequate Representation on The Pierce County Human Services Citizen’s Advisory Board (CAB)

The CAB is a tripartite board structure with a minimum of nine members and a maximum of fifteen members. One-third of the membership is comprised of democratically selected low-income individuals, or their representatives.

Organizations representing low-income persons and low-income individuals may petition for adequate representation on the Pierce County Human Services Citizen’s Advisory Board.
