Random Check of Ballots

Per RCW 29A.60.170(4) a random audit of batches is required. On March 10, 2020 the political party observer coordinators requested the required audit of ballots be conducted for the Democratic Party Primary and the Republican Party Primary. Our system uses up to five digital scanners and one central count server. A random batch from each scanner used in the election (3 Democratic batches and 2 Republican batches) were drawn, hand tallied, and compared to the machine report. All results of the hand tally for the chosen race matched the machine report.
