



**Notice of 30-Day Public Comment Period, Public Hearing and Availability of Substantial Amendment to 2019 One Year Action Plan**

**Notice**

Pierce County Human Services is making available a Substantial Amendment to the Human Services 2019 One Year Action Plan for public review and comment for 30-days from April 1 through May 6, 2020. This is the second substantial amendment to the 2019 One Year Action Plan.

**About the 2019 One Year Action Plan**

The Department of Housing and Urban Development requires Human Services to submit a One-Year Action Plan detailing the department’s 2019 allocations of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). These funds assist the homeless population and low-income people, households, and communities throughout unincorporated Pierce County, as well as the Pierce County Consortium, which consists of 18 cities and towns. The 2019 One Year Action Plan was submitted to HUD and approved on July 3, 2019. This is the first amendment to the 2019 One Year Action Plan.

**Substantial Amendment #2 to the 2019 One Year Action Plan**

This is the second amendment to the 2019 One Year Action Plan. This substantial amendment repurposes 2019 CDBG public facilities funds that were originally awarded to the YWCA/Pierce County Affordable Housing Project in the amount of \$250,000 to the Pierce County Community Development Corporation (CDC) for their Economic Development (ECD) Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) Program. In exchange, the YWCA/Pierce County Affordable Housing Project will receive Pierce County general funds in the amount of \$250,000 to fund the construction of counseling and case management services for low-income and homeless individuals and families. The ECD RLF has been in existence over 20 years and the \$250,000 is being added to the RLF to help businesses with COVID-19 recovery resources. The CDC will use the funds to assist for profit businesses in the creation or retention of jobs per HUD requirements. For every \$35,000 loaned the applicant will document they will be retaining or creating a new job. This will be project #22 in IDIS in the 2019 program year.
