

PIERCE COUNTY LEOFF 1 DISABILITY BOARD
VISION HARDWARE POLICY

(Revised - Effective March 16, 2011)

\$250.00 per 12 month period is allowable for the purchase of eyeglasses or contacts.

This flat rate amount may be applied to any portion of the cost for eyeglasses or contact lenses, lens coatings, etc., not to include the exam.

The cost for the eye exam is separate from this hardware allowable amount. The eye exam should be covered by the medical insurance provided to the member by their former agency, or paid directly by the agency if no insurance coverage is provided.

The allowable amount for one pair of eyeglasses (lenses and frames, coatings, etc.) or contact lenses, not both, is limited to once in a 12 month period.

Glasses broken or damaged in the line of duty will be replaced upon receipt of a written incident report from the member and written confirmation from the member's supervisor.

Any amount in excess of the allowed \$250, for which a member seeks reimbursement, must be presented by the member to the Pierce County LEOFF 1 Disability Board.
