



**Notice of Substantial Amendment to 2020 One Year Action Plan for
Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) CARES Act Funds**

Notice

Pierce County Human Services is notifying the public of a Substantial Amendment to the Human Services 2020 One Year Action Plan for the first round of the ESG CARES Act Funds.

About the 2020 One Year Action Plan

The Department of Housing and Urban Development requires Human Services to submit a One-Year Action Plan detailing the department’s 2020 allocations of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). These funds assist the homeless population and low-income people, households, and communities throughout unincorporated Pierce County, as well as the Pierce County Consortium, which consists of 18 cities and towns. This is Substantial Amendment #1 to the 2020 One Year Action Plan.

Substantial Amendment #1 to the 2020 One Year Action Plan

This Substantial Amendment to the 2020 One Year Action Plan awards the first allocation of the ESG CARES Act funds in the amount of \$908,579. The programs selected fall under the emergency shelter component of ESG. Funds are to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19) and will be allocated as follows:

Administration	\$90,858
Catholic Community Services/Nativity House Overnight Shelter	\$339,657
The Rescue Mission/Adams Street Family Shelter	\$25,197
The Rescue Mission/Emergency & Outreach Services	\$452,867
TOTAL	\$908,579
