Random Check of Ballots

Per RCW 29A.60.170(4) a random audit of batches is required. On August 4, 2020 the political party observer coordinators requested the required audit of ballots be conducted for the 29th Legislative District, State Representative Pos. 2. Our system uses up to five digital scanners and one central count server. A random batch from each scanner used in the election was drawn, hand tallied, and compared to the machine report. All results of the hand tally for the chosen race matched the machine report.

Write In

A declared write-in (William Rowland) filed in the 2nd Legislative District - Position No. 2 race. This is a cross-county legislative race shared with Thurston County. Only one regular candidate filed for the office. The Office of the Secretary of State asked us to tally write-ins for this race. The declared write-in needs to receive at least one-percent of the vote in this race to advance to the General Election ballot.

William Rowland's write-ins were tallied. He received a total of 48 votes in Pierce County.

Mandatory recount

A mandatory recount is required in the 29th Legislative District - Position No. 2 race. The 2nd and 3rd place candidates are separated by 82 votes or .44 percent. This will be a machine recount consisting of a review of the undervotes in the race. We ask the canvassing board to set the recount for Friday August 21, 2020, 9 a.m. at the Election Center. The canvassing board will meet on the same date at 10 a.m. to certify the recount.
