

### Penalties for Reckless Driving at Ferry Facilities

Reckless driving on Pierce County Ferry Facilities including waiting lanes, loading areas, and aboard ferry vessels poses a danger to our passengers, our crew, and our infrastructure and will not be tolerated.

The Pierce County Ferry system will impose penalties (in addition to any imposed by law enforcement) for drivers who engage in reckless driving (as identified in RCW 46.61) while aboard a ferry or at any ferry facilities. This includes vehicle accidents and/or injury to persons or property, or other driver behavior as a result of reckless vehicle operation; or which result from failing to follow ferry employee direction.

The Airport and Ferry Administrator will provide an initial written warning for reckless driving. Additional incidents will result in the driver being suspended from using the Pierce County Ferry for 30 days, or longer if warranted.

### Roles and Responsibilities

**Airport and Ferry Administrator** is responsible for reviewing incidents and imposing penalties.
