### Load Balancing

The Pierce County Ferry has space constraints and load balancing considerations that affect our ability to load oversize and overweight vehicles, equipment, and cargo.

### Modular Homes No longer Accepted

Due to these space constraints and balanced load considerations, Pierce County Ferries will no longer accept the movement of modular homes.

### Other Oversize/Overweight Loads

Pierce County Ferries may not accept other oversize/overweight loads that negatively affect ferry service. All requests for oversize/overweight cargo must be submitted and approved in advance. Any questions regarding a specific cargo size and weight can be directed to the Airport and Ferry Administrator.

### Roles and Responsibilities

**Airport and Ferry Administrator:** Implements the policy, reviews requests for oversize or overweight loads for compliance with this policy.
