<b>City of Buckley Proposition No. 1</b>  (360) 829-1921	<b>Fire Station Construction Bonds - \$5,000,000 for 30 years</b> Authorizes the District to issue bonds for the construction of a new fire station.	392 <b>Total votes</b> plus a 60% favorable margin
<b>City of Edgewood Referendum No. 1</b>  (253) 952-3299	<b>Gross Receipts Utility Tax</b> The qualified electors of the City have filed a referendum petition. If approved this measure would authorize the District to impose a 3.5% utility tax on the gross receipts of providers of telephone service, cable television, natural gas, electricity, sanitary sewer, storm water and solid waste collection and provides that this utility tax automatically expire 36 months after the effective date.	Simple Majority
<b>City of Orting Proposition No. 1</b>  (360) 893-2219 ext. 111	<b>Annex the City of Orting into Fire Protection District 18</b> To pass, this proposition must be approved by both the voters of the City of Orting and by the voters of Fire Protection District 18.	Simple Majority
<b>Fire Protection District No. 18 Proposition No. 1</b>  (360) 893-2221	<b>Annex the City of Orting into Fire Protection District 18</b> To pass, this proposition must be approved by both the voters of the City of Orting and by the voters of Fire Protection District 18.	Simple Majority
<b>Fire Protection District No. 18 Proposition No. 2</b>  (360) 893-2221	<b>Increase the Board of Fire Commissioners from three to five members.</b>	Simple Majority
<b>Metropolitan Park District of Tacoma Proposition No. 1</b>  (253) 305-1092	<b>Maintenance and Operations Levy Lid Lift</b> Authorizes the District to lift the tax levy limit to fund the restoration, preservation, maintenance and operation of park and recreation facilities and programs. This proposition would increase the property tax levy rate to \$0.75/1,000 valuation for collection in 2011.	Simple Majority
