<b>City of Milton</b> (253) 922-8733	<b>Fire, Paramedic and Emergency Medical Services Levy Lid Lift</b> Authorizes the City to lift the tax levy limit to fund Fire, Paramedic and Emergency Medical Services. Authorizes the City to levy for collection in 2011 the regular property tax at a rate not to exceed \$3.00 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation.	Simple Majority
<b>Fire Protection District No. 2 (Lakewood)</b> (253) 582-4600	<b>Maintenance and Operations Levy</b> Authorizes the District to levy excess property tax of \$1.00 per \$1,000 of assessed value for maintenance and operations and to maintain the current level of fire and emergency medical services.	2,883 <b>YES</b> votes plus a 60% favorable margin
<b>Fire Protection District No. 16 (Key Peninsula)</b> (253) 884-2222	<b>Regular Property Tax Levy for Emergency Medical Services</b> Authorizes the District to levy up to \$.50/1,000 assessed valuation for each of 10 consecutive years beginning in 2011, to continue providing emergency medical services, including advanced life support (paramedic) services.	1,262 <b>YES</b> votes plus a 60% favorable margin
<b>Fire Protection District No. 17 (South Pierce)</b> (253) 847-4333	<b>Emergency Medical Services Property Tax Levy</b> Authorizes the District to levy up to \$.50/1,000 assessed valuation for each of 6 consecutive years beginning in 2011, to continue providing basic and advanced (paramedic) emergency medical services..	1,041 <b>YES</b> votes plus a 60% favorable margin
