Shoreline Substantial Development Permit/ Shoreline Conditional Use Permit: VanDerschelden Applications 950103, 950104

Applicant: Dale VanDerschelden

Request: Remove remnants of the old County road that ran along this shoreline, add a 2-foot wide cap onto the top of the existing bulkhead, construct inset beach access stairs into the bulkhead, remove a boat storage cover, add a 25-foot by 12-foot boathouse, add a path extending upslope from the old road to a new home, and construct a 4-foot tall retaining wall at the toe of the slope. Located at 466 6th Avenue, in the Rural 10 zone classification, Residential Shoreline Environment, Gig Harbor Peninsula Community Plan area, and Council District 7.
